Book Guide for:

## A Mud Pie for Mother

Author and Illustrator: Scott Beck

### Supplies Needed:

*A Mud Pie for Mother*, soil and water or playdough, bread, eggs, milk and honey.

### Before Reading:

Make a mud pie with soil and water or use playdough. Sing “Old McDonald Had a Farm” to review farm animals. Use 1 cup of milk and one egg beaten together to make a batter for French toast. Soak bread in milk and egg mixture and fry in a pan using melted butter. Brown the bread on each side and put on a plate. Eat with honey on top.

### During Reading:

The reader names the animals and the child points to them in the book. The reader points to an animal and asks, “What’s this?” The child names the animal. The reader makes animal sounds and the child points to the animal that makes that sound. The reader points to an animal and asks, “What sound does this animal make?” Point out the following things to the child as you read the story: flower, basket, eggs, milk, etc.

### After Reading:

Make some more mud pies or play with the playdough. Look for animals as you go out in the community. Make animal sounds when you see a particular animal.
