Book Guide for: A Lot of Otters!

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Before Reading:

Let your child hold the book and look at the different pages with you. You can point and name things that you see in the book. Talk about what is happening on each of the picture.

During Reading:

This is a great bedtime story which you can read to your child in a quiet, calm voice.

Just relax and enjoy the book together with your child.

After Reading:

At another reading of this book, away from bedtime, you could some of the following activities:

Count the number of stars and/or otters in the book

Talk about what is in the book the boy/otter is holding

Talk about how the mother finds her boy

Talk about what the otters do with the stars.

Talk about what happens to the boy and the otter at the end of the story.

Ask your local librarian to recommend other great books that are just right for bedtime.

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
