



**Book Guide
for ABC KIDS**

Supplies Needed:

ABC Kids, pencil, paper, camera, film, stapler, glue, refrigerator magnet (optional)

Before Reading:

A few days before reading the book, talk with your child about the letters of the alphabet. Look for letters in different places with your child. Show your child that her name starts with a letter and write her name. Put your child's name on your refrigerator using magnetic letters.

During Reading:

While reading the book, have your child point to the item starting with the letter in the picture. Next, have her say the word. If you see a pictured object in the room, have her touch it. For example, "face", have your child touch her face. If you can act out the action, do so ("kiss", give each other a kiss or "laugh", laugh out loud).

After Reading:

Take pictures of you and your child doing various activities, or pictures of her favorite items, "blankie", "cookie", and "dog". Create an ABC book for your child by gluing the pictures on to paper. Don't forget to write the letter and name of the item.
