**ABC Look At Me**

## Before Reading:

Let your baby or toddler hold the book, look at it, chew on it, or play with it. Let your child enjoy the book in their own way.

## During Reading:

When you and your child are in a relaxed mood, sit and look at the book together. Do a few pages at a time. Don't worry about the letters. Point to the picture and say the expression on the baby's face (i.e. baby, angry). Make the expression with your face and say the word again. See if you child copies you.

## After Reading:

Find a mirror that you and your child can look at together. Make a face, wait a few seconds to see if your child copies you. Then say the word, wait again, your child will repeat the word. Do several different faces. Have Fun!

## Related Reading:

Go to the library and ask for the section with baby books. These books usually have hard cardboard covers to withstand the rough treatment that babies give books.
