## Supplies Needed:

## Before Reading:

Ask your child, what is a mother, what do mothers do and what activities can a child do with their mothers? Talk with your child about the characteristic traits that the two of you share and do not share.

## During Reading:

While reading the book, stop and discuss each animal. Ask your child how Choco and the animal on each page are alike and how they are different. Ask your child if the animal on each page could be Choco's mother.

## After Reading:

Draw a picture with your child of the two of you doing something really great together.
