Book Guide for
Alphabite! A funny feast from A to Z.

Author/Illustrator: Charles Reasoner

Supplies Needed:

Alphabite!, magnetic letters

Before Reading:

Make the magnetic letters available for the child to use in a convenient location, such as a refrigerator door. On the day that you read the book, remove the letters from the refrigerator and spread them out on the floor. Sing the alphabet (ABC) song.

During Reading:

As you prepare to read a page, work together with your child to find the capital and lower case letters shown at the top of the page. After reading the page, move these letters to the refrigerator. Check the top of the page to see that the two letters match what is shown at there.

Sing the ABC song, touching each pair, and stop when you have sung about each pair on the refrigerator. Continue this until all pairs are on the refrigerator door and you can sing the song from A to Z.

After Reading:

Listen for rhymes. Open the book to show two pages, such as A and B. Reread the lines on these pages. Call out the last word on the left page, then the last word on the right page. Point out these rhymes to your child. As you go along, your child may be able to tell you the rhyme before you point it out.
