Supplies Needed:

Tomie's Baa, Baa, Black Sheep and other Rhymes

Before Reading:

Read the book to your self. There are four nursery rhymes in the book: Baa, Baa, Black Sheep, Jack and Jill, Little Miss Muffet, and Hey, Diddle Diddle. Try memorizing the four rhymes so you can say them over and over again to your child.

During Reading:

Young children like to flip from page to page and not necessarily in order. When your child stops at a page of the book, read the caption at the bottom of the page.

Point at things in the pictures and name them for your child. Talk about the page. Also, while the child is flipping pages, say the whole nursery rhyme to them.

After Reading:

Every chance you have, say the nursery rhyme with your child. Act it out for them. Show them how much you enjoy nursery rhymes. Nursery rhymes provide a strong foundation for later school success.
