## Supplies Needed:

*Big Brother, Little Brother*

## Before Reading:

Talk with your child about what a brother is. Make a list of brothers: the child's brother, parent's brother, grandparent's brother, etc. Let them discover that some families have brothers and some do not. Go through and look at the pictures with your child. Have them tell you what they think is happening in the picture.

## During Reading:

Read each page of the book with your child. Say the special word on each page a little louder. Now, go through the book with your child one more time. This time say the special word on a page. Ask your child, if they know why the author is using that word. (If they are not sure, go over what is happening in the picture with them.)

## After Reading

If your child has a brother, take some photos of them together. Mount the photos on construction paper. Together, with your child, write a sentence to go with each photo. Make a book of the photos or put them up on the refrigerator.

If your child does not have a brother, your child can draw some pictures of what your child would do with an imaginary brother.

## Related Reading:

Go to the public library and see if they are any more books about brothers.
