



Book Guide for:
Boom Chicka Rock

Supplies Needed:

Boom Chicka Rock, paper plate, magic marker or crayon

Before Reading:

Find clocks, watches, etc., throughout your house. At each clock, have your child say the numbers that on the clock face. Your child will get the idea that all clocks have the numbers 1-12 on the face of the clock.

During Reading:

This is a fun book, so enjoy reading it with your child. Each of the numbers are printed in bold, large letters, so be sure to say them with emphasis. Try saying them louder or longer to make sure your child hears the number words. Also find the numbers in the pictures – they are printed on the mice pants. Have them repeat the phrase, when it occurs, “Boom Chicka Rock, Chicka Rock”.

After Reading:

Take the paper plate (a white one is best), write the numbers of the clock face. Have your child say each number as you write them on the plate. Ask your child to name a time of the day that he/she likes, then draw the hands for that time. Now give the paper clock to draw what he/she likes to do at that time on the back of the clock.
