## Supplies Needed:

*Corduroy Goes to the Doctor*, plastic funnel, and plastic tubing

## Before Reading:

Let your child hold the book and play with it. While looking at the book, talk to your child about going to the doctor. Talk about the last visit you and the child made to the doctor's office.

## During Reading:

Young children like to flip from page to page and not necessarily in order. When your child stops at a page of the book, read the caption at the bottom of the page. Point at things in the pictures and name them for your child. Talk about the page. Make up your own story about the pictures.

## After Reading:

Attach a plastic tube to the end of a plastic funnel. You now have your very own stethoscope. Put the funnel to your child's chest and the other end of the tube to their ears. They should be able to hear their own heart beat.
